

The building just east of the CVS/City Center apartments, is actually another parking garage, not a residential building.

“The Residences” (the HopCat building) is really 8 stories tall (not 5) and is modern, and orange/silver, not like this.

Right here is the 7-11, not a park.

This park-like area is actually where Harper’s Restaurant and Brew Pub is located.

This is where the “colorful parking structure” is in fact located.

This shows the planned new 12-story structure that would front Grand River Avenue.

The building, holding Urban Outfitters and Lotsa Pizza, remains.
